



Qlik® Technology Grant Eligibility Guidelines

Licensing

Qlik offers several licensing options to meet the needs of nonprofit organizations through its Technology Grant Program. Eligible nonprofits can receive up to ten (10) free Qlik licenses, including support services. Additional Qlik licenses, training services, and support services are available and will be evaluated on an individual application basis.

Eligible Organizations

Nonprofit or charity institutions are eligible for the Qlik Technology Grant Program if they have a declared and verifiable charitable or philanthropic mission to benefit communities, including, but not limited to: providing humanitarian or disaster relief, supporting global health initiatives, advancing civil society, delivering education, restoring the environment, and championing human rights. To be eligible, organizations must be a 501(c)(3) organization qualified by the Internal Revenue Service. Nonprofit or charity institutions located outside of the United States must provide documentation that validates their charitable and nonprofit status in their respective country. Qlik will provide a list of acceptable documentation to meet this requirement upon request.

Ineligible Organizations

The following institutions are ineligible under the Qlik Technology Grant Program:

- Nonprofit organizations without recognized charitable status in their respective country;
- Organizations driven by a political agenda;
- Healthcare providers without substantial funds raised from public fundraising**;
- Federal, state, and local Governmental organizations or agencies;
- Public and Private Education Institutions, including K-12 schools, colleges and universities***;
- Commerce and trade associations without charitable aims or activities benefitting non-members;
- Political and labor organizations

** Healthcare providers without substantial funds raised from public fundraising can participate as a supporting partner organization. Please contact Qlik for more details.

*** Higher education organizations may apply for the Qlik Academic Program Grant for Qlik licenses to be used in a classroom education setting. Please contact Qlik for more details.

Nondiscrimination Policy
